Ways to Get Involved:

1. Sponsor a Holiday Party at one of our nine sites.

- Purchase gifts for each Club Member and help run our holiday party. (Shopping can be performed by your organization or Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Cincinnati)
- Each child is able to chat with Santa and then allowed to visit Santa's workshop to select a present. Basic refreshments are provided.
- Each Club averages between 75-160 kids. Average gift cost is \$15. Estimated cost for gifts and refreshments: \$1,200-3,000.
- Employees/group members are invited to help hand out presents, serve refreshments, lead activities and direct children.*

2. Help fund a winter trip to Perfect North Slopes.

- Give our members the experience of snow tubing by donating toward the ticket cost and possible transportation to Perfect North.
- Estimate of 15-40/kids. Average ticket cost is \$25. Estimated cost for trip: \$375-\$1,000.
- Employees are invited to help chaperone if desired.*

3. Adopt-a-Family

- Many of the families we serve are disadvantaged. Sign up to adopt a needy family and provide gifts to make their holiday special.

3. Donate gifts.

- Not able to sponsor a party but still want to help? Simply donate new gifts that are appropriate for boys or girls between the ages of 6-18.
