## **Boys & Girls Club to Expand Evening Transportation Routes**

(Vanceburg, KY) Beginning August 5<sup>th</sup> Boys & Girls Club of Lewis County (BGCLC) will be expanding their evening transportation routes. Previously, three buses provided transportation home after the Club had closed. Now, six buses will be transporting students from the Club at 5:40 pm to existing locations and expanded areas of the county. The expanded areas include: Laurel-Emerson, Concord, Quicks Run, Firebrick, Grayson Spur, Trace Creek Road, Town Branch Hill, Indian, and Oak Ridge. Children that do not ride the evening buses can still remain at the Club, and parents may continue to pick them up any time before 6:30 pm.
