Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Cincinnati CEO Bill Bresser Named Ohio Alliance CEO of the Year

CINCINNATI, Ohio (DATE) – [Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Cincinnati](#) (BGCGC) announced today that President & CEO Bill Bresser has been named CEO of the Year by the Boys & Girls Clubs Ohio Alliance, recognizing his leadership, service and lasting impact on youth and communities across the region.

Bresser received the award during the Ohio area council state summit in Columbus where Boys and Girls Clubs leaders gathered to celebrate club excellence and plan for the future.

The CEO of the Year award honors individuals who demonstrate exceptional leadership, meaningful contributions to their local Clubs and communities, and a commitment to advancing the mission of Boys & Girls Clubs at the regional and national levels.

Since becoming CEO in 2018, Bresser has led a period of significant growth and momentum for BGCGC. During his tenure, the organization’s annual operating budget has grown from \$4.1 million to \$6.7 million, expanding its ability to serve more youth and families across Greater Cincinnati.

He has also played a central role in advancing the organization’s “A New Generation” campaign, the largest capital campaign in BGCGC history, which secured more than \$50 million to support facility improvements, program expansion and long-term sustainability.

“Bill is an inspiring leader for the Clubs. It is a pleasure to watch him work,” said Dick Williams, Board Chair, BGCGC, and CEO, Skyline Chili. “He can comfortably interact with anybody — the kids, the staff, the parents and the board members. Under his leadership, the Clubs have set higher goals and standards and created better accountability. He is all in at whatever he does. I



am not sure how he accomplishes as much in a day as he is able to. It has been a real pleasure to support his passion.”

The Ohio Alliance, which advocates for funding, awareness and support of Boys & Girls Clubs across the state, evaluates nominees based on leadership, service, professional involvement and demonstrated dedication to youth development.
